Furniture was moved around to create as many separate spaces as possible for both diners and drinkers, and it's worked very well. The new reality means that things will continue to be slightly different when you visit.

In order to adhere to government guidelines and to make sure we can remain open, please note:

- Drinking at the bar is currently not allowed
- We will serve you at the table - which means that we cannot serve you unless you have a table to sit at
- A maximum of six people are allowed at one table - inside or outside. The six people can be from multiple households
- Groups of more than six people will be split between two or more tables
- Due to limited space, please book a table if you want to eat in
- Hand sanitisers will be placed around the building and we encourage you to make use of them
- You will be asked to leave contact details to assist the Government's Track and Trace programme. This is a requirement for both diners and drinkers
- Above all, please remember that we are in the middle of a pandemic. Many people feel vulnerable about it, so please show respect and be kind

The Asian takeaway menu has been put on hold for the time being. However, our pizzas are available to take out. The takeaway menu will be under constant revision and tailored to demand as we go along - so keep an eye out for possible winter curries!
